Course Completion Breakdown Admin Only	<i>This report will show administrators course progress for all students in each course by decile percentage.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> When admins need a high-level view of how students are progressing through the school year. When admins want to focus on courses where students are falling behind.
Course Percentage Complete	<i>View the percentage of course completion along with the current scores for completed assignments.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> When needing quick data on courses nearing completion. TIP: be sure to pull this report at least one month before grades are due to conference with students.
Course Progress Monitor Admin Only	<i>This report will show administrators the number of students who are behind, on target, or who have not yet started a course.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> When admins want to focus on courses where students are falling behind.
Detailed Student Grading	<i>Monitor student grades at the assignment, unit, and course levels along with time on tasks.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> When a detailed report to show student mastery is needed. When data is needed for each assignment, including time opened and time submitted, individual assignment scores, and cumulative unit and course scores.
Faculty Progress Admin and Super Teacher Only	<i>Displays teachers' daily to-dos for their students.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To ensure teachers are responding to student needs/actions in a timely manner. To ensure student grades are accurate and reflect the work they have completed.
Group Overview Teachers and Super Teachers can only view group members allowed by their user role	<i>This report will show the course grade and percentage complete by course for all the members of a selected group.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> When a high-level overview of progress and success for a group of students as a whole is needed. This view functions as a roster view.
Group Progress Teachers and Super Teachers can only view group members allowed by their user role	<i>This report will show the average course grade and percentage for your group by enrollment.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To gather a range of student data for a group, including low, high, and average percentage of course completion and low, high, and average score achieved.

Login/Logout Times	<i>See how much time students spend logged into their student accounts.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To capture the amount of time a student logged into Odysseyware. • To monitor seat time.
Pre/Post Test Scores	<i>Monitor growth through a pre-test/post-test score comparison for courses using CRx Mode.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When needing to show growth from the beginning to the end of a unit.
Student Activity Daily Breakdown	<i>A detailed log of students' daily activity in their courses.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When detailed information is needed about daily navigation time, including a total for each day, and total duration for the term of the course.
Student Activity Summary	<i>Calculates student time-on-task for each enrolled course over a specified time frame.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When a summary of navigation time by course is needed.
Student Lesson Plan	<i>Observe all student assignments for courses along with their due dates.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When assignment information is needed – will show all assignment due dates for a course, comparable to a syllabus. • When students need an assignment list to assist in keeping them on track. • When course content is audited.
Student Progress	<i>A comprehensive look at your students' scores, progress, and time on task.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When meeting with students before the end of a grading period.
Student Unit Grades	<i>Monitor student scores unit-by-unit along with their cumulative scores for completed units.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When an overview of unit grades and course score is needed. • When a term is completed and final grades need to be captured. • To view student progress at a high level.
Track Grade Overrides Admin Only	<i>Show changes to student assignment grades and what teacher made them.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To ensure efficacy of the program.
